The **Smart Anything Everywhere – EC Consultation Workshop** will discuss the needs, trends and visions for **Digital Transformation** and the deployment of digital technologies by SMEs in different application domains. The interactive workshop will discuss emerging research and technology fields through a Technology Radar to fuel digitization, as well as the needs and barriers for a broad and successful implementation by SMEs. The main focus will be on the evolution of the SAE Initiative in order to provide:

- improved (future) offers to SMEs in terms of 'test before invest',
- innovation support and skilling/training,
- closer collaboration amongst the EU-wide network of supporting Digital Innovation Hubs (DIHs).

Recommendations for Horizon Europe will also be presented and discussed with the aim of building an effective future network that will have a real impact on SMEs and the EU economy. The workshop will gather experts from related projects, Innovation Actions, SME clusters, national/regional initiatives and also from policy-making, which will elaborate on solutions to jointly meet the challenges of Digital Transformation for European Industry.

## THE OBJECTIVE OF THE INTERACTIVE WORKSHOP WILL BE TO ELABORATE ON THE

- **Technology Radar:** Which are the emerging technologies supporting digital transformation, and how mature are they? How can SMEs effectively test them?
- **Lessons learnt:** What are the experiences in SAE, I4MS, national and regional initiatives supporting SMEs in 'Digital Transformation' and what can we learn from them?
- Vision: Evolution of SAE and the overall network of DIHs across Europe (now and under Horizon Europe). Where do we want to go? Who are the key players and how do we create an ecosystem that can fully exploit the impacts?
